Accounting and Finance

ACFI 101 Accounting Lab

(1 credit)

Corequisite: ACFI 100 Fundamentals of Financial Reporting

This course is a required co-requisite of ACFI 100 for small-group structured learning assistance. Under faculty supervision, students acquire financial statement analysis and spreadsheet utilization skills to help them succeed in accounting. Students in this course will attend a weekly tutorial session led by a peer learning assistant (PAL) in which they will engage in inquirey-based and small-group problem solving. This course is graded on a (P)Pass/(N)No Pass basis.

Psychlogy

PSYC 585 Mindfulness-Based Stress Reduction: Clinical Applications (3 credits)

Prerequisite: Matriculation and the completion of first year in Psychology, MA, Social Work, MSW, or Counselor Education, Mental Health Counseling, MEd. Consent of instructor required. May be repeated for a maximum of 6 credits.
